- Our teen & young parenting outreach continues to grow and remain strong, reaching young parents with the support, education, and mentorship they need to build a bright future for themselves and their children.

I am the Pregnancy and Adoption Counselor for APO. I feel privileged to be here to not only offer services to birth parents considering an adoption plan, but to offer post-adoption services to all parties involved for as long as they need us.

As an adoptee and birth mother myself, I have a deeply rooted passion for adoption. I would say it started the day the adoption social worker placed me in my dad's arms under the cross at Lutheran Social Services in Austin.

When I faced a crisis pregnancy as a teenager, I rested in the security of an adoption plan for my daughter. It was a gut-wrenching decision, but it was the best decision for both of us. I am most grateful that she has lived a beautiful life.

I can happily say that I recently heard her voice for the first time since the sweet baby coos I remember from holding her as a newborn. With all of the ups and downs and the heartache adoption can encompass, it has been a blessing in my life and ultimately molded me into who I am today.

I was in high school when I realized I wanted to make a difference in adoption and make it my career. When I started at DePelchin Children's Center in Houston, my position was in the Post-Adoption department. I worked with clients experiencing all stages of the post-adoption process, from immediately after birth and placement to years down the road when adoptees and birth parents requested search and reunion. This is where my passion for post-adoption began and remains rooted today.

I bring this passion to APO because I believe those of us living in the world of adoption need each other. We need like-minded support, ongoing access to adoption education, professional and knowledgeable guidance, and the availability of life long professional services.

My love for adoption runs deep and my commitment to birth parents and adoptive families has only grown stronger in time. I love what I do and can't imagine my world without adoption in it!

My husband, John, and I have two daughters who are the joy of our lives. Alee is a Kindergarten teacher in Navasota and Olivia is Office Administrator for a custom home builder in Bryan. They both love Jesus and make us proud every day. They have made parenting feel very easy, and they are my proudest and most joyous achievements. Oh, and I have my first grandbaby coming in a few months! The excitement is overflowing within our little family, as we wait for baby Colt to show us his sweet face! Thank you for hearing my story and heart.

I consider it a blessing to have met my birth mom when I was 18. I was always curious and needed to make sure my birth mom knew that I was ok and that I loved her. My birth mom was a wonderful person and I am grateful for the years I was able to spend with her before she passed away.
